The Facts:

- Sine and Cosine values are NEVER undefined.
- The other trig values are ONLY undefined at angles ON an axis. $\left[0\pi, \frac{\pi}{2}, \pi, \frac{3\pi}{2}, 2\pi\right)$
- $\frac{0}{1}$ is 0. $\frac{1}{0}$ is undefined.
- The reciprocal of 0 is "undefined".
